

NOAA Nautical Charting Calendar

Desktop Chart Icons

NOAA's 1,000-plus coastal and Great Lakes nautical charts are viewable on the Internet. Use these on-line charts as a ready reference or planning tool. Icons for individual charts can be put on your computer desktop. To do this, go to one of the Viewer regional lists of chart numbers displayed at <http://www.nauticalcharts.noaa.gov/mcd/OnLineViewer.html>.

Then drag your favorite chart number(s) onto the desktop by putting the mouse pointer over the chart number, holding down the left mouse button, dragging the number to an open area of your computer screen, and releasing the mouse button. Next time you want to view this chart, double click the chart icon on your computer screen.

The On-Line Viewer charts are up to date with all Notices to Mariners corrections. The banner at the top of each chart's display shows chart metadata including the "Clear Dates" which are the latest NGA Notice to Mariners (NM) and Coast Guard


