



# NOAA Nautical Charting Calendar



## Federally Regulated Areas

Regulated areas are established to prevent damage or marine casualties, to protect waterfront facilities, and to safeguard ports, harbors, and the environment by restricting access to authorized persons and vessels. The establishment of these areas is under the jurisdiction of the USCG and USACE. Regulations and limits governing and defining specific areas are published in Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations.

Regulated area limits are depicted according to the following criteria:

- Regulated Navigation Areas, Safety Zones, Defense Areas/Zones, and Security Zones are shown by a dashed magenta line (0.20/2.0/0.75 mm).
- Danger Zones, Firing Areas; Missile, Exercise, and Prohibited Areas are shown by a dashed magenta line (0.25/4.0/1.0 mm).
- Seaplane Landing Areas and Seaplane Restricted Areas are shown by a solid 0.20 mm magenta line.
- Restricted Areas are shown by a T-dashed magenta line (0.20/2.5/1.2 mm). A 2.5 mm (20 percent, 120 LPI) magenta screened band can be added to highlight the dashed limiting line.

Regulated areas are identified by the primary title of the area (e.g., "*DANGER ZONE*", "*PROHIBITED AREA*", etc.), the assigned alphanumeric designator, the CFR section number, and a reference to the standard Note A all in 7 pt. Swiss Light italic type and in magenta. Note A is reserved for the note listing the publications that contain navigation regulations relevant to that chart; other charted notes begin with Note B or other reference label even if there is no [Note A](#). Text statements and condensations of regulations are not charted where the regulations are published in the CFR and the Coast Pilot.
